PLAN AN EVENT

 Maybe you could have a Coffee Morning; Afternoon Tea; BBQ; Picnic; Movie & Pizza night; Dinner; Party or hold a recognition event and ask a local personality or council to present certificates – it's up to you! (you can download and customise your own certificates - see link on page 5)



- Decide on a date, time and venue and think about a realistic budget. Perhaps seek sponsorship from local businesses for financial or in-kind support
- Think about dressing the venue with balloons and some entertainment or background music

ISSUE A PRESS RELEASE

Inform local media about your event. Think about profiling one of your volunteers (see template press release on page 5)
