Habitat for Humanity - ReStore Volunteer



Habitat ReStore is a low cost DIY store that sells donated new and used building supplies and home improvement materials. SEHSCT - Volunteer Laundry Driver



Volunteer Driver needed to deliver and collect laundry at patient/client homes, using access key pad if necessary, being careful to maintain confidentiality, collect payment from patients/clients and maintain a record. Provide information to patients / clients about the voluntary laundry service. Lisburn Outlook - Tandem Pilot & Sighted Guide



Tandem Pilot - Tandem cycling is a great way to remain healthy and get involved with blind and partially sighted people in your local area. The volunteer pilot rides on the front, while the blind or partially sighted person (the stoker) pedals behind. You will regularly participate in cycle rides of different lengths with local stokers and describe the scenery as you cycle both urban and rural routes. bit.ly/2HuopJQ
