Triple A - Volunteer Support Worker

Triple A meet three times a week from 11am to 2pm. They need a volunteer to provide as much time as possible to enable the group to fully meet their potential. The volunteer will have support from the activity leader. Volunteers will never be expected to take the group without assistance. In house training will be provided. bit.ly/333FUuK



Armagh Rural Transport - Social Car Driver Volunteer

The Social Car Scheme is provided by Volunteer Drivers in their own cars, providing door to door transport for members who have difficulties using public or other forms of transport into town, health appointments, social activities. Volunteer Drivers are given expenses per mile. The service is offered Monday - Friday 8am - 6pm. Volunteers can choose their own hours within these times. bit.ly/38xvdBT
