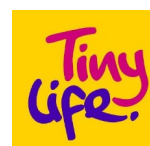
## Fermanagh Community Transport - Volunteer Driver

Fermanagh Community Transport have a number of Volunteer Car Driver opportunities. (especially volunteer drivers in the Teemore, Roslea, Enniskillen and Newtownbutler areas). Volunteers must be aged over 25 years and hold a current valid Drivers Licence for more than 2 years
