The Helpline provides free, confidential, information, advice and support to victims of elder abuse, as well as others who are concerned about or have witnessed abuse, neglect or financial exploitation. You will be provided with full training, call-handling equipment and ongoing support and guidance from our staff and other volunteers. We will cover all out-of-pocket expenses and provide certificates for completed training.

Deafblind UK



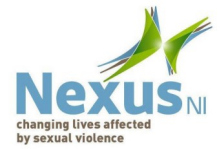
