Home-Start Lakeland - Family Support Volunteer



Volunteers offer support and friendship to families with young children (at least 1 child aged under 5) in the family's own home for 2 – 3hrs per week. Volunteers will receive full training and must commit for at least 1 year. Volunteers must demonstrate a sensitive and caring attitude towards others, have a clear understanding of the confidential nature of the Home-Start service and not break confidences shared by the family, other than when disclosure is essential in order to protect the well-being or safety of a child. bit.ly/3q4CNvm

Please note those who are extremely vulnerable (shielding) are unable to volunteer for the British Red Cross unless in a role they can do from home. Volunteers must be over 18, hold a full driving license and have access to a vehicle. Volunteers should live within 10 miles of catchment areas. This role requires an Access NI check.

Equipment can be collected from our network of 'spokes', based in Red Cross premises, hospitals or medical centres, or we can arrange for delivery/collection. Volunteers will liaise with the hub to arrange stock deliveries/collections and deal with enquiries from people wanting to borrow a wheelchair or other equipment. bit.ly/3qDeqI3
