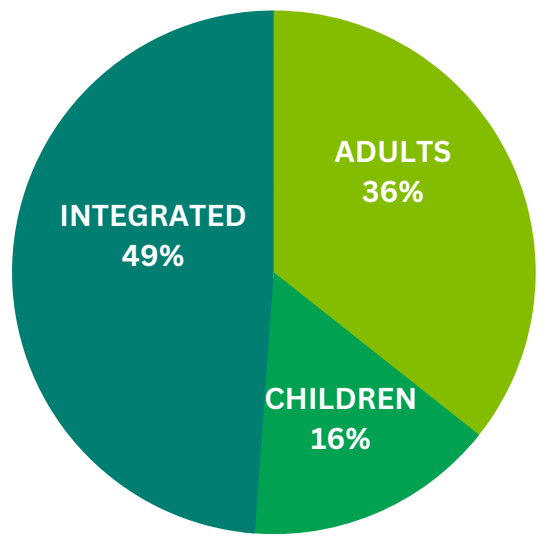

- 1 Staff recognition, vigilance, and ability to follow procedures
- 2 Online risks
- 3 Lack of public awareness and knowledge
- 4 Insufficient staff/volunteer resources in volunteer-involving organisations and statutory bodies
- 5 Issues going undetected
- 6 Availability of sufficient/adequate/consistent training
- 7 Lack of a joined up approach, communication, or the variety of different approaches applied
- 8 Getting something wrong, or missing something
- 9 Keeping our volunteers safe and protected
- 10 Too much legislation
