Independent Monitoring Boards Volunteer (Larne)

Independent Monitoring Boards are made up of over a thousand unpaid volunteers operating in every prison in England and Wales, and every immigration detention facility across the UK. IMB members are the eyes and ears of the public, appointed by ministers to perform a vital task: independent monitoring of prisons and immigration detention. They report on whether the individuals held there are being treated fairly and humanely and whether individuals are being given the support they need to turn their lives around. This can make a huge difference to the lives of those held within these facilities. From 25/09/2023 we will be looking for volunteers to join the Independent Monitoring Board to monitor Larne House short term holding facility.
