#### **RISP Questionnaire**

The Department for Communities is seeking views on draft proposals for future Infrastructure Support of the Voluntary and Community Sector in Northern Ireland. Public consultation is now open!

They have carried out a programme of extensive engagement to refresh their approach to supporting sector infrastructure and develop an <u>integrated policy framework</u> to underpin future funding programmes.

The Department for Communities are now keen to share what they have learned from engagement sessions and seek views on their proposed framework through a public consultation. The proposed framework and consultation documents can be found <u>here</u>.

#### **Check your information on Be Collective!**

It's good practice to routinely check your details are all correct on the Be Collective platform.

- Are you approaching the closing date for your opportunity and need to extend it?
- Have you uploaded a logo and header image? This will help with the algorithm on Be Collective and can make your opportunities more visible.
- Is the contact person for your opportunities still correct?
- Have you given people enough time to apply for your opportunity? *don't have your closing date too tight!*

#### **Messaging on Be Collective**

The platform allows users to message the volunteer manager, group or message an individual. If a member uses the 'message to group' function the message will go to everyone! #### Free defibrillators from British Heart Foundation

Find out if your community group is eligible for a free, BHF-funded defibrillator. Having a defibrillator and knowing how to do CPR will give members of your community a better chance at surviving a cardiac arrest. **Applications will close on 15 March 2024**.
