The training of the **ILM level 3 award in Volunteer Management** includes a brief initial induction session on 27 October where learners meet each other and the trainers and are guided through the technical aspects of the course. The first learning session is on 6 November (10am-1pm) which focuses on volunteer onboarding and agreements. The second learning session is on 13 November and it focuses on best practice in volunteer support and supervision. And then there is a final 'assignment support' session on 17 November with learners being given an additional month to complete and submit learning assignments.
