Fleadh Cheoil na hÉireann - Belfast 2026 – Volunteer Now

The world's biggest celebration of traditional Irish music and culture is coming to Belfast. The city has been confirmed as the host of the 2026 Comhaltas Fleadh Cheoil na hÉireann. The festival has grown massively in recent years, with hundreds of thousands of people attending, and the Fleadh in Belfast will mark Comhaltas's 75th year, with Ards CCÉ also celebrating their 50th year. The Fleadh in Belfast will run from **Sunday 2 August 2026 until Sunday 9 August 2026**. Events range from large concerts and big name acts to street performances, pop-up gigs and community céilís, while competitions in music, song and dance range from local county and regional level to provincial and All-Ireland titles. **Volunteers** have and always will be at the heart of Fleadh Cheoil na hÉireann.
