Our driving scheme provides transport to isolated, older people to attend healthcare appointments. If you enjoy driving and meeting new people, this is the volunteering role for you. This is a fairly flexible role, where you can drive based on your own availability week-to-week. However all of our drives are Monday-Friday during the day. BEFRIENDING VOLUNTEER – VOLUNTEER NOW

Volunteer Now's Befriending Scheme supports people aged 60+ living in Belfast who are socially isolated and/or lonely, living in their own homes and cannot get out and about, attend activities or see friends and family like they used to. The scheme is funded by the Belfast Health & Social Care Trust and referrals to the service are received from Social Workers. Volunteers are matched with a service user and usually visits once a week for 1 to 2 hours to provide company. and hopefully, week on week build a friendship that the older person enjoys and looks forward to. Volunteers are needed for 1 to 2 hours each week and should be able to commit to a minimum of 6 months.
